Myanmar Prayer Points

- 45 people recently attended a baptism, 15 of them were unbelievers. They heard and saw the gospel; **pray** that many more will choose to give their lives to the Lord.
- In April the biggest local holiday “Thingyan” occurs. This water festival was originally focused on washing away sins of the previous year. Now, it’s just a time to play with water. As we gathered Sunday for fellowship, games and Bible study, 3 non-believers joined us! **Pray** for the Lord to reveal Himself and for them to follow in belief.
- As the water festival began, we went down to a river to baptize 6 new believers! A 70 year old man and his daughter, a blind man and woman, a stoic man whose heart was softened by his wife’s prayers after her own baptism. **Praise** God for the beauty of the gospel and the power of prayer. You have played a part in each one’s story!
- Teaching English gives us great opportunities to meet new people. Christmas events and birthday parties are opportunities to share with families. I have also been able to meet with an English teacher to explain how much God loves him. **Pray** he will choose to have a personal relationship with God, leaving behind any connection to Buddha.
- Over the last few months we’ve seen multiple miracles, including 3 non-believers who begged us, “Please come and teach us the Bible. We want to believe but don’t have anyone to explain it to us.” God is moving in power! **Pray** for our continued energy to meet the needs of those around us and share the gospel whenever we can. We’ve also face the challenges of a crumbling economy. With only 4-8 hours of electricity per day, cooking, homeschool, laundry, and sleeping are impacted. Thankfully we will soon have a solution to this problem. Thank you for giving generously to the Cooperative Program and Lottie Moon so we can receive these blessings!
- In the past, as we shared the hope we have, we often saw polite and patient listening with glazed-over eyes. But this Christmas we heard wonderful questions and encouraging comments from those who are considering the gospel and the cost of becoming a believer. **Pray** they will continue to seek God.
- In the last two years, there has been a general sense of hopelessness in Yangon. Many have struggled to feed their families as the price of food has increased. Opportunities for education or a good job have decreased significantly, leaving many people discouraged and depressed about the future. Many have even lost hope in their Buddhist faith. In the midst of the darkness, God is at work changing hearts. **Pray** that unbelievers will be open to the truth of the gospel. Ask that many would experience hope and joy through a relationship with Christ.
- There are many Bible-believing churches in Yangon, but the majority of them are hesitant to share the gospel outside the church walls. **Pray** for local pastors and believers to catch the vision to make Christ known in their communities. Ask that they would be bold in sharing the gospel with neighbors.
