FERN'S STORY

Unexpected teenage pregnancy

Fern dropped out of high school and moved in with her boyfriend and his family. Six months later she found out she was pregnant. She and her boyfriend considered aborting the baby.

Encounter with ELM Team

Fern eventually decided she wanted to keep the baby, but she worried that her boyfriend's income from working at the market would be insufficient to support them. One of the ELM Team members, Katie, met with Fern and encouraged her that she was making the right decision to keep her baby and then showed her pictures of the baby's developmental stages in the womb.

Chose life for her baby

Katie and other ELM Team members continued to meet with Fern each month to encourage her, explain key components of a healthy lifestyle during pregnancy, and share the hope that is found in Christ. Three months later Fern gave birth to a healthy baby girl. Her boyfriend got a new job and his wages now provide for their basic needs. The ELM Team continues to meet with them regularly to provide support as they adjust to life as new parents.
